

DIRECTIONS TO NJIT CEILI & SOLO PRACTICE THIS WEEKEND

FROM THE SOUTH

GARDEN STATE PARKWAY NORTH TO EXIT 145 (ROUTE 280), TAKE 280 EAST TO EXIT 13 – NEWARK. (when you come off the parkway route 280 is five lanes wide, get into the middle lane). **Make a right at the end of Exit 13, First Street, Newark. Go to the 3rd traffic light (Central Avenue) and make a left onto Central. Take Central Avenue approximately one mile to Martin Luther King Blvd. (Mueller's Warehouse is on your right and St. Michael's Medical Center is on the far left hand corner). Turn right on ML King Blvd., go to first traffic light (Warren Street) and turn right. Go two blocks, turn left and follow road to NJIT parking deck. Turn right into deck and tell them you are with the Peter Smith School. Dan has managed to secure free parking in this lot but you must tell them that you are with the Peter Smith School. Come out of the parking deck on the same side that you went in, turn right and the Theater is one block up on your left hand side.**

FROM THE NORTH

Take 80 West to 280 West and follow directions above in **BOLD TYPE**.

FROM THE WEST

Take 78 East to the Garden State Parkway. Take Garden State Parkway to Exit 145 for Route 280 East and follow directions above in **BOLD TYPE**.

FROM THE TURNPIKE

Take the New Jersey Turnpike to Exit 15W for Route 280 West. Take Route 280 West to exit 14 – Clifton Avenue, follow the exit ramp to the traffic light. Make a left hand turn on Clifton Avenue and follow Clifton to the third traffic light (Central Avenue). Make a left on Central Avenue and follow directions above.
