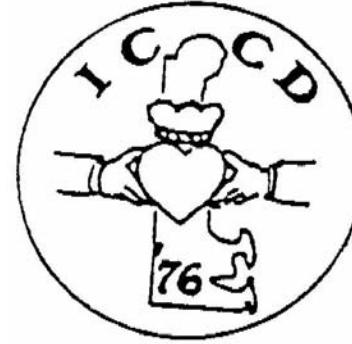

DIRECTIONS

FROM BALTIMORE & SOUTH: Take I-95 to Exit 3, ****ROUTE 273 WEST**** (toward Newark). At FIRST TRAFFIC LIGHT TURN RIGHT (Harmony Road). Follow Harmony Road approximately 1.5 miles to ROUTE 2 – KIRKWOOD HIGHWAY – TURN RIGHT (Harmony Road dead-ends into Kirkwood Highway). Follow Kirkwood Highway about 1 mile to the traffic light just past Burger King on your right – TURN LEFT AT LIGHT – PIKE CREEK ROAD – St. Mark's is .2 miles just around the corner.

Beginner:

A Beginner is a competitor who has not taken Irish dancing lessons from a registered teacher prior to September 1st of previous year. A Beginner must move into Advanced Beginner the following year. **2 Steps, 2 Dancers at a time.** As of January 1, 2008 competitors in Beginners must wear either a school costume or blouse & skirt. **NO SOLO COSTUMES.**

Irish Bread: Competition #800

No entry fee. Entry card must be received by the Feis Secretary no later than July 25th. Bread is to be delivered in plastic wrap prior to 11:00 a.m. on the day of the Feis and will become the property of the Feis.

Preliminary Championship:

A dancer who has placed 1st in both light and heavy Open dances and has never won 1st, 2nd or 3rd in Open Championship. *Mid-Atlantic Rule: Dancers who win three 1st place preliminary championships in one calendar year must move onto Open or as soon as the 3rd win is achieved in the following years. Must specify on entry card **REEL(48 Bars) OR SLIPJIG(40 Bars)** and **HORNPIPE(48 Bars) OR JIG(40 Bars)!** All age groups under 14 will dance 3 at a time if the stage is 24' X 28'. All age groups over 14 will dance two at a time.

Reel or Slip jig, Hornpipe or Jig, and set of choice from approved list. SPECIFY REEL (48 bars) OR SLIPJIG (40 bars), HORNPIPE (48 bars) OR JIG (40 bars), AND SET PIECE OF OWN CHOICE ON

FROM PENNSYLVANIA: Take I-95 SOUTH and follow directions from ****FROM NEW JERSEY/NEW YORK:** Take Delaware Memorial Bridgel-95 SOUTH and follow directions above from ****.**

ENTRY. All age groups under 14 will dance 3 at a time if the stage is 24' X 28'. All age groups over 14 will dance two at a time.

ENTRIES MUST INCLUDE: Competitor's name, address, phone number (include area code), Email address, IDTANA Teacher's name, Dance school, date of birth, age as of January 1, 2008, competition numbers- including reel or slip jig and hornpipe or jig for preliminary championships and reel or slip jig, hornpipe or jig, and name of set for open championships, and parent or legal guardian signature.
